The Bedlam Charity

Bedlam Row consisted of 16 rent free cottages in Bleathwood. In 1748 an exchange of land took place with the Dansey family in order to provide houses for the poor, let on a 99 year full repair tenancy. In 1876 J.R.Bailey of Easton Court bought the entire row of houses for £152 and the tenants then had to pay rent and some were ordered to quit. This sum was invested to support the poor where the Poor Law arrangements otherwise would not help. For more details see LH Parish Hall website, News.
